Fund Description

This fund seeks to provide investors with consistent, competitive performance through favorable stock selection while monitoring risk. The Fund typically invests in small- and mid-sized companies across the growth and value spectrums. The portfolio management team seeks to identify companies it believes have sustainable long-term business models and a demonstrated commitment to environmental, social, and corporate governance ("ESG") policies.

Investment Strategy/Process

The portfolio management team looks for small- to mid-sized companies that have strong growth prospects, are in an industry with a positive economic outlook, have high-quality management, and/or have a strong financial position, as well as a demonstrated commitment to ESG policies. The team seeks to identify companies that have sustainable long-term business models that drive financial success and risk management. The Fund actively focuses on ESG factors as part of its fundamental analysis, rather than merely applying exclusionary screens to specific sectors or industries.
