**Fund Description**

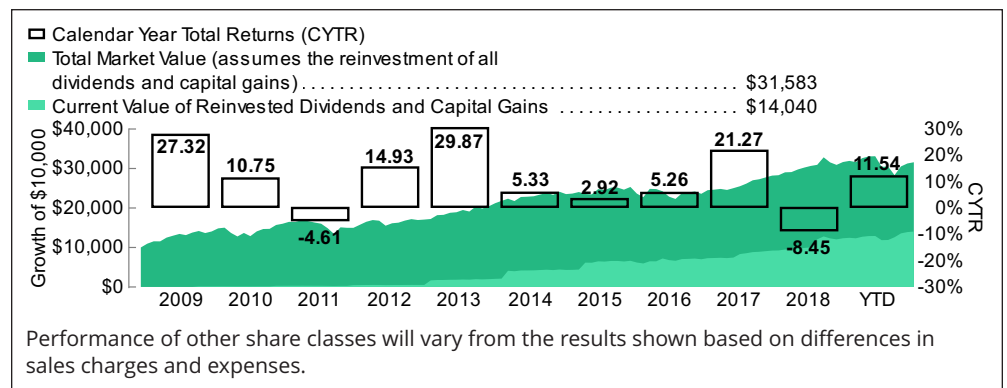
Thrivent Large Cap Stock Fund looks to provide investors with consistent, competitive performance through favorable stock selection while monitoring risk. The Fund typically invests in a globally-diversified portfolio that includes a combination of both large-cap “growth” stocks and “value” stocks. Growth stocks are companies whose earnings are expected to grow at an above-average rate relative to the market. Value stocks are companies that trade at a lower price compared to the market average, as measured by valuation ratios that compare the stock’s price to the company’s earnings and growth trends. Large companies are generally considered to be more stable, but may not have the fast growth potential of smaller companies or the ability to respond as quickly to competitive challenges and changing market conditions.

**Effective April 30, 2019, Thrivent Large Cap Stock Fund will be renamed Thrivent Global Stock Fund. See prospectus supplement for more information.**

**Investment Strategy/Process**

The portfolio management team seeks to add value through stock selection and active management, and monitors risk in an effort to build a well-diversified, global portfolio. The team uses fundamental, quantitative and technical investment research techniques to identify and purchase financially-sound companies that appear to have strong, long-term growth prospects and and capable management teams.

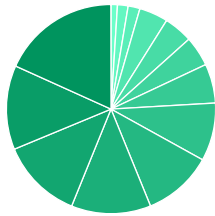

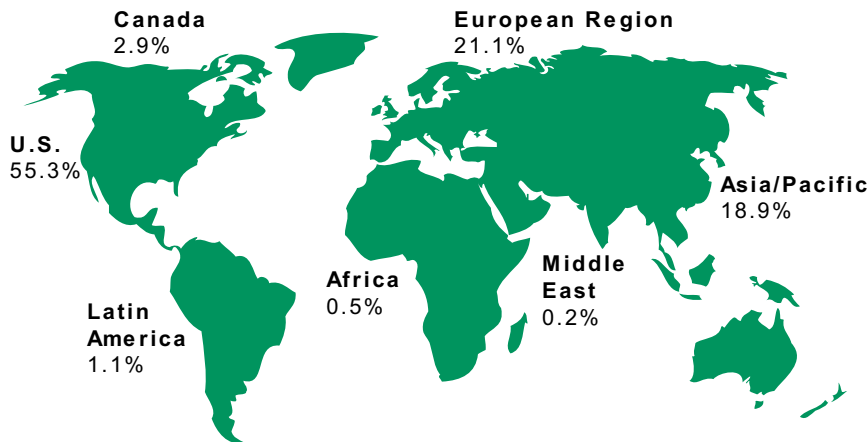

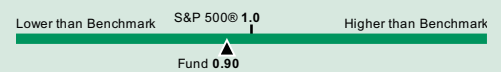
